Arrangement and Composition

Tasks:

1. Take pictures of yourself:

Take pictures of yourself standing, sitting, working, running. Use a digital camera but if you do not have one, use manual and develop your photographs. Bring your photographs next week.

The photographs MUST be of you doing something. Take also take pictures of other objects that will accompany you, e.g. desk, cat, bed, etc.... make sure the whole object is in the picture.

2. Micro Territories

Identify and photograph a micro territory. Micro territories can be considered spaces that are primarily small and a part of larger objects. Places like the space under a chair, a chair seat, inside a bin, cracks in the ground, space under a crisps packaging that's been thrown away, under a bus seat etc, edge of a sink, smooth surface of bath, carpet, etc.. Pick 2 locations and photograph from 6 different angles each. Zoom right in and try to capture the background too. Make sure that the detail of the territory is clear and the background can be out of focus, but still apparent.

3. Composition

Populate your Micro Territories with a picture of yourself.

4. Add

Add other objects, wall cabinets, plants, furniture, and other items matching the scale of yourself.

5. Print 2 A3 Images

Print and Present in 2 weeks.
